Notice is hereby given that the North Springs Improvement District intends to purchase **88 Flygt Pumps** for wastewater lift stations across the District. NSID believes that this procurement meets the requirements of a Sole Source purchase under **Florida Statute 287.057(5)(3)(c)**.

Challenge Submission Guidelines

Any vendor, manufacturer, or qualified entity intending to contest this notice must submit a formal written challenge. To be considered, challenges must demonstrate the capacity to meet the exact specifications detailed herein and be received by the District no later than **11:00 AM on August 19, 2026**.

- **Technical Documentation:** Submissions **must** include comprehensive product specifications to facilitate a rigorous compliance verification against District standards.
- **Burden of Proof:** The challenging party bears the sole responsibility of providing definitive evidence that their proposed equipment is a direct, drop-in replacement that meets or exceeds all performance, physical, and electrical specifications without infrastructure modification.
- **Administrative Reference:** All correspondence must clearly cite the Sole Source Information inquiry number: Document Number 2026-07.

Required Technical Specifications

The following specifications must be met in order to submit a valid challenge to this notice of intent:

I. Large Municipal Submersible Pumps

These specifications apply to the heavy-duty pump replacements.

- **Quoted Models:** Flygt 3000 N-Series (Specifically Models 3085, 3127, 3140, 3152, and 3171)
- **Horsepower (HP):** 10 HP, 15 HP, 20 HP, and 35 HP sizes
- **Impeller Technology:** Adaptive N-Impeller (Self-cleaning, anti-clogging geometry)
- **Electrical/Voltage:** A mix of 230-Volt and 460-Volt configurations (site-dependent)
- **Cable Lengths:** Potted submersible power/control cables in a mix of 50-foot and 65-foot lengths
- **Explosion-Proof (HazLoc) Rating:** The 20 HP pumps were specifically quoted with "FM" (Factory Mutual) ratings, indicating they are built for Class I, Division 1 hazardous locations
- **Wet Well Cleaning:** The 10 HP, 15 HP, 20 HP, and 35 HP pumps were quoted with the note: "volute is prepared for Flush Valve."
- **Discharge Connection:** Designed to drop in on standard Flygt guide rail bases

II. Grinder Pumps

Specifications applicable to stations currently serviced by Hydromatic SPG and Flygt equipment.

- **Quoted Models:** Flygt M-Series
- **Horsepower (HP):** 1.7 HP to 3.0 HP sizes
- **Cutting Mechanism:** Municipal-grade shredding/cutting wheel (designed for high-torque maceration of fibrous materials and wipes)
- **Electrical/Voltage:** 230-Volt and 460-Volt configurations (site-dependent)
